Help to Health is a volunteer driver service delivered by County Durham charities Volunteering Matters and Supportive. Between them they have over 40 years experience of transporting patients to their doctors and hospital appointments. Transport is available Monday to Friday 8:30am to 5:30pm.

You can book up to four weeks before your appointment but we need at least 48 hours notice. The service will be charged per mile. When your booking is confirmed we will tell you how much your journey will be.

The Great North Air Ambulance Service (GNAAS) operates three helicopters, 365 days a year, across the North-East, North Yorkshire and Cumbria. GNAAS crews respond to around 1,000 call outs each year and on board our aircraft are specialist trauma doctors and paramedics, who bring accident and emergency expertise to the scene.

Residents & Police WhatsApp group

On the back of our two public meetings with Officers from Durham Constabulary it was suggested that a WhatsApp group should be set up as a way to send messages quickly and easily to let everyone know about suspicious vehicles or activity.

Recently it has lead to two positive outcomes for crimes that have occurred locally.

The police do have access to the group, however it is **NOT** monitored by them 24/7.

It's important to remember that this is not a way to report crime! Should you witness an **ACTIVE** crime, you should report it to **999** immediately. If you discover a crime has already taken place, you should report it to 111.

In both instances above you will be issued with a Crime Reference Number. We have been advised by the police to mention any crime reference numbers in any messages in the groups, as it allows people to easily pass any information on to the police.

For obvious reasons the group is closed, meaning that only 'Admins' can add people.

Thanks to opportunities provided by The Wellesley Trust at The Community Foundation Tyne & Wear and Northumberland and The Hedley Foundation, Quad Bike Training was also delivered for two trainees on Thursday, 5th July and Lantra 13-15 Tractor Driving training on 24th July. This was in addition to Pre Test Tractor, Car Driving Lessons and Car & Trailer Lessons. So far 31 successful applicants have been reimbursed towards their driver training from The Wellesley Trust and The Hedley Foundation and we are so grateful to these funders.

Four Days of British Wool Shearing Courses

The UTASS British Wool Shearing Courses were held on Monday 25th & Tuesday, 26th June, with a second course on Wednesday, 27th & Thursday, 28th June. Excellent facilities in Woodland were provided by kind permission of John & Fay Hutchinson, with a record 14 trainees attending. We would like to thank the Warren Group Ltd for agreeing to once again help local trainees with providing funding towards the cost of the training. Thanks too to Richard Schofield and Bill Mason for their encouragement and patience. It was brilliant to see those who already know how to shear, wanting to learn more and coming along to improve



their skills. Congratulations to all trainees on the British Wool "Seals" they achieved and thanks go to Barbour who very kindly donated all the trainees' outdoor clothing as an extra bonus.

Comments from trainees include:

"I thoroughly enjoyed the course, it was also lovely to meet the other people on the course. Bill and Richard were both great!"

Funding for Weardale Rural Skills Training

We are hopeful that another similar project providing part funding for eligible Weardale trainees might be approved shortly, to open up opportunities to support the farming community. It is hoped that Lantra Abrasive Wheel Machines, NPTC Safe Use of Sheep Dip, NPTC Certificate of Competence for the Transport of Livestock and XL Vets Managing Medicines will be added to the courses delivered previously which are listed below. (The DIY Artificial Insemination for Cattle training is no longer available locally and would not be included.)

We would welcome enquiries about these courses as minimum numbers will be needed for training courses to run. Over the last two years 49 trainee places, part or fully funded from Weardale Action Partnership have been provided by the Weardale Rural Skills Training as detailed below:

- 13 for NPTC Safe Use of Pesticides training & assessment (2 days training & trainee pictured below from May 2018)
- 2 for the Semex DIY Artificial Insemination for Cattle (4 days training)
- 4 for British Wool Marketing Board Sheep Shearing (2 days training)
- 7 for Lantra Chainsaw (2 days training)
- 5 for Trailer lessons in preparation for B+E Test
- 6 for NPTC City & Guilds Level 2 Award in Land-based Forklift Truck Operations (Rough Terrain, Masted and Telescopic Types) (2 days training)
- 10 for Emergency First Aid Training (1 days training fully funded)
- 2 for Dry Stone Walling (3 day course held October 17)

Lantra Award in Chainsaw Maintenance & Crosscutting

NPTC Certificate of Competence for the Transport of Livestock (Cattle & Sheep) - Rodenticides – please call our Office to request a copy of the AHDB publication "Rodent Control on Farms" booklet with details of how to access on line training and Lantra assessment, if required.

NPTC Level 2 Award in the Transport of Animals by Road (Short Journeys) – Cattle & Sheep are classed as one species. Although no training is required, those interested will receive information to prepare beforehand. Qualification handbook 600/0306/6 states "This qualification is aimed specifically at people transporting animals over 65Km and up to eight hours in duration, where the journey is in connection with an economic activity". Please contact John Jones on 01768 898731. The above qualification ties in with requirements for a **business** to apply for an **Animal Transporter Authorisation** for the above journeys, which is free of charge. This Animal Health and Plant Agency application form needs to be completed and returned to the Welfare in Transport Team at Carlisle and can be obtained from UTASS.
